We have practiced the routines and students know the rules and consequences in art class. Occasionally, some students have difficulty following the rules and misbehave. Students will get 3 chances before a letter is sent home.

If a letter is sent home, please talk to your child and let them know that we care about their learning and expect them to behave appropriately in art class. The letter is to be signed by you and returned the next day.

\* Grade 4-6 students may listen to music on their personal devices using earphones while they are working, but no games, videos or surfing the internet.
